Supervisor Behling opened the regular Town Board meeting at 7:00 with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Councilor Robert and seconded by Councilor Greenway to approve the following resolution. The motion was adopted by a vote of 5 ayes Behling, Barber, Greenway, Partrick, and Robert, and 0 nays.

Resolved the Mexico Town Board approves the minutes from the September 13, 2021 town board meeting.

Public Comment and Concerns:

Concerns were: the status of the lawsuit with the county, water district 6, extending water to LaRobardier Road, Pop Warner football requesting use of the community park, and the village water tower status.

Reports:

Town Clerk/Water Clerk - A motion was made by Councilor Greenway and seconded by Councilor Robert to accept the September town clerk/water clerk reports as presented. The motion was adopted by a vote of 5 ayes Behling, Barber, Greenway, Partrick, Robert and 0 nays.

Dog Control Officer- none

Zoning Officer / Building Inspector –A motion was made by Councilor Greenway and seconded by Supervisor Behling to approve the report as presented. The motion was

adopted by a vote of 5 ayes Behling, Barber, Greenway, Partrick, Robert and 0 nays. Partrick asked if there was a building permit for the barn on Kranz Rd. Marsden said yes, the owner is eventually going to build a house.

<u>Highway Superintendent</u> – A motion was made by Councilor Greenway and seconded by Councilor Robert to approve the report as presented. The motion was adopted by a vote of 5 ayes Behling, Barber, Greenway, Partrick, Robert and 0 nays. Barber asked if Munger Hill Rd. would be marked. Partrick said that none of the town roads are marked.

Community Park – A motion was made by Councilor Partrick and seconded by Supervisor Behling to approve the report as presented. The motion was adopted by a vote of 5 ayes Behling, Barber, Greenway, Partrick, Robert and 0 nays. Greenway asked if the maple tree would be taken down. Yerdon said yes. There was a discussion about Pop Warner using the park.

Mexico Point Park – Casey's Cottage is closed for the season. The Friends of Mexico Point Park are applying for a grant but to qualify, they need both a 501c3 and a memorandum of agreement from the state. The Friends have a 501c3 and are in the process of applying for a memorandum of agreement. The grant would be either for a wheelchair accessible trail from the parking lot to the waterfront or to enhance Roop's Loop trail.

Behling relayed information from Bond regarding dead trees and limbs that need to be removed and that the street light is still broken. The bath house will remain open for as long as weather permits. Partrick said that he received a quote from Midstate Lawn & Tree Service for the removal of the broken limbs, dead trees, and grinding of the stumps. Partrick asked about storage of a camper on park property.

A motion was made by Councilor Robert and second by Councilor Partrick to approve the report as presented. The motion was adopted by a vote of 5 ayes Behling, Barber, Greenway, Partrick, Robert and 0 nays.

RESOLUTION SETTING STATUS UNDER SEQR AND ASSUMING LEAD AGENCY STATUS

Town of Mexico Community Park Drainage & Upgrades Project

WHEREAS, the Town of Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Town", is proposing to cause to be constructed a community park drainage and upgrade project to serve town residents, businesses, and institutions; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mexico Town Board must evaluate all proposed actions submitted for its consideration that may affect the environment in light of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) and the regulations promulgated thereunder; and

WHEREAS, the involved agencies [as that term is defined in 6(A-2) NYCRR 617.2(t)] include the New York State Department of Health and the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, and the required environmental review will be conducted solely by the Town of Mexico Board: and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mexico Town Board desires to serve and act as the lead agency for the purposes of SEQR; and

WHEREAS, to aid the Town of Mexico Town Board in determining whether the Action may have a significant impact on the environment, a Short Environmental Assessment Form dated __10/11/21____ has been prepared by the Town and a copy of which has been filed with the Town Clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Mexico Town Board that:

The Town of Mexico Town Board makes the following findings and determinations with respect to the proposed project:

The project constitutes an "Unlisted Action" as that term is defined in Section 6(A-2) NYCRR Section 617.2(kk) and 617.11;

The Town of Mexico Town Board desires to serve as lead agency for the purposes of SEQR.

The Town Clerk shall cause the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and NYS Department of Health, as the other "involved agency" to be notified of this resolution.

This resolution shall take effect immediately.
